

PowerCheq Operating Manual Clarifications

The following items should be noted when installing and using the PowerCheq modules:

- A 3A mini-ATO fuse is used instead of a 2A mini-ATO fuse as specified in the current operating manual.
- The current operating manual specifies that a tie wrap is included in the PowerCheq package. A tie wrap is no longer included.
- A dimly-lit red LED is an indication that the PowerCheq is installed correctly and functioning as expected. This is not mentioned anywhere in the current operating manual. The red LED is dim enough when turned on in this manner that it is difficult to see in broad daylight. Cupping your hands over the module or waiting until it is dark outside will help to see if it is on. When lit due to an error, it is not difficult to determine that it is on.
- Although it should be avoided, the PowerCheq leads can be disconnected in any order without damaging the module. If at all possible, the connecting/disconnecting scheme described in the operating manual should be used to prevent any possible damage.
